

## CALL FOR PROJECT PROPOSALS

The Global Environment Facility Small Grants Programme (GEF SGP) in Namibia in collaboration with UNDP provides small grants up to US\$50,000 directly to eligible CSOs and CBOs for community-based environmental projects.

The SGP in Namibia hereby invites project proposals from CBOs and eligible CSOs that want to be considered for this funding. **Preference will be given to proposals from the following areas:**

- Otjimbingwe communal area
- Iipumbu Ya Tshilongo landscape
- Ohangwena region

### Funding and selection criteria:

Projects must seek to address environmental problems of national concern, contributing also to global environmental benefit at least in one of the following areas:

- Conservation of biodiversity
- Climate change
- Land degradation and sustainable forest management
- International waters
- Prevention of harmful chemicals
- Capacity development
